Part 1: Evaluation of the Effectiveness

1. Evaluation of the objective:

Since the Reading Fund provided extra resources for the purchase of reading materials, apart from English books and English magazines, online resources of Britannica School, Britannica Science Pack and Humanities Pack are purchased to enable students to be exposed to a variety of reading materials from different sources.

2. Evaluation of strategies

Due to the Coronavirus, the school has been suspended for a long time and many students' activities are cancelled, therefore the activities including the Reading Month activities were cancelled.

With the purchase of Britannica resources, it is hoped that English subject, Science and Humanities subject will be able to incorporate the reading materials into their curriculum, for example as materials for challenging questions in exams.
