***The major objectives for Promotion of Reading: Creating a Reading Culture***

Part 1: Evaluation of the Effectiveness

1. Evaluation of the objective:

Since the Reading Fund provided extra resources for the purchase of reading materials, apart from English books and English magazines, online resources of Britannica School, Britannica Science Pack and Humanities Pack, Hyread (Chinese ebooks), ebooks on STEM are purchased to enable students to be exposed to a variety of reading materials from different sources and the access of these materials via eClass can enhance the convenience of reaching the e-resources.

2. Evaluation of strategies

Due to the Coronavirus, the school has been suspended for a long time and many students' activities are cancelled, therefore the activities including the Reading Month activities were cancelled.

With the purchase of e-resources and ebooks of various KLAs, it is hoped that more diverse reading materials can be integrated into their curriculum as extended learning and resources for challenging questions in assessments.
